ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above, the Government have withdrawn seven corridors of roads from corporation of Chennai and entrusted them to the Highways Department for further improvement and maintenance. The Government also ordered therein that the Chennai Corporation should transfer funds to the Highways Department for improvement and maintenance of the said roads. In the letter second read above, the Commissioner, Corporation of Chennai has reported that the Council in its meeting held on 06/08/2002 has passed a resolution for handing over of certain Corporation Roads to Highways Department vide Resolution No.287/2002, dated 06/08/2002.

2. At a high level Meeting held under the chairmanship of Secretary to Government, Finance Department on 14/08/02, it was informed by the Chief Engineer (General) Chennai Corporation that out of 82.63 Kms. of roads, Corporation has already applied for loan for 30.99 Kms. of roads and this amount can be released to the Highways Department soon after the Corporation receives the money from TUFIDCO. During the meeting it was decided that the actual requirement of the fund for the improvement and maintenance of roads of 82.63 Kms. to be taken over by the Highways Department will be determined by Chief Engineer (General), Highways Department, in consultation with the Chief Engineer (General), Chennai Corporation and

the Highways Department will forward the requirement of funds to MA&WS Department for the issuance of a G.O., permitting MMC to borrow loan from TUFIDCO (including for the balance of roads (82.63 – 30.99 Kms.) and allowing the works to be executed by the Highways Department as already ordered.

3. In pursuance to the above decisions taken in the meeting, the Government now permit the Corporation of Chennai to borrow loan from TUFIDCO and transfer the same to Highways Department for improvement and maintenance of the roads for 82.63 Kms. for which the Chief Engineer (General) Highways Department has sent detailed estimates of the roads.

4. This order issue with the concurrence of Highways and Finance Department vide its U.O. No.18044/HW.1/2002-1, Dated 03/09/2002 and U.O. No.65881/MAWS/2002-1, Dated 09/09/2002 respectively.
